CANCELLATIONS & REFUND:

* **For cancellation before 90 days prior to departure \$100 per person.**

* **For cancellation of 90 to 46 days prior to departure, a cancellation fee of 50% of the tour cost will apply.**

* **For cancellation of 45 to 16 days prior to departure, a cancellation fee of 75% of the tour cost will apply.**

* **For cancellation of 15 days and less prior to departure, a cancellation fee of 100% of the tour cost will apply.**
